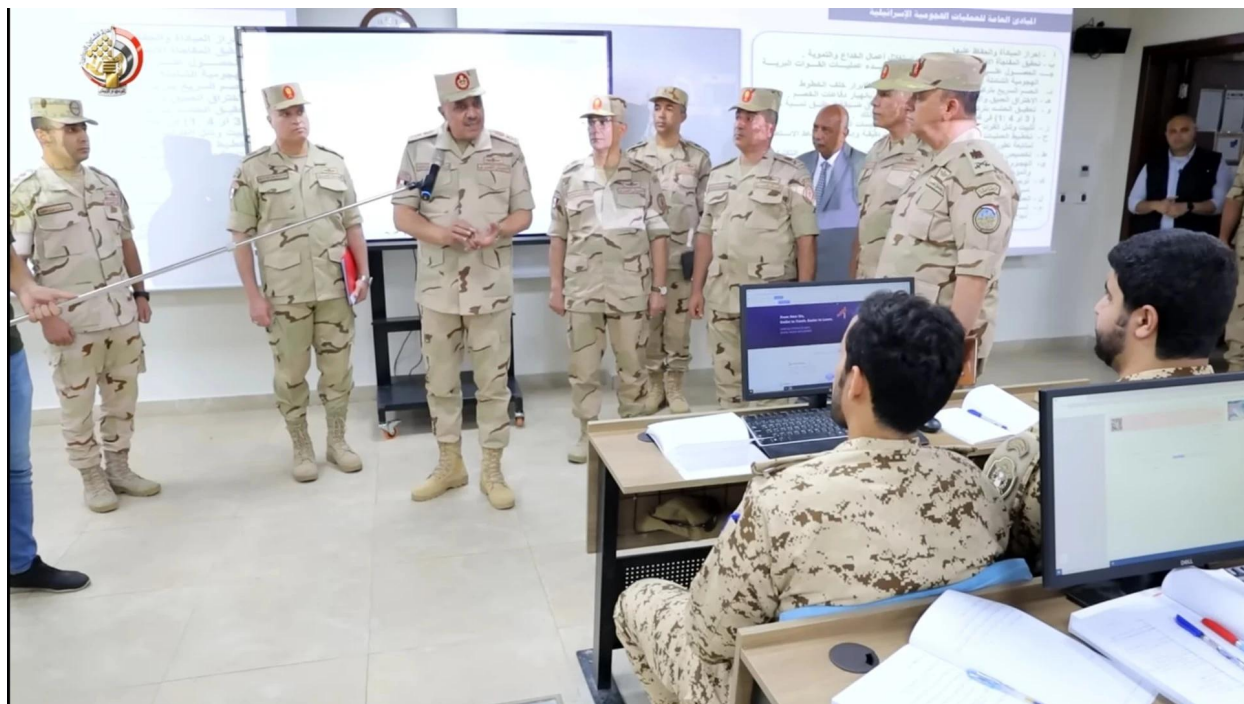


A Snapshot Reveals the Egyptian Army's Study of Israeli Doctrine
